1. Meeting started with a NAWS update/presentation. Basically an overview of what NAWS has been up to since the 2016 WSC and an update on IDT's

Our region and other regions have issues selecting effective, diverse speakers. Topics tend to be less solution based and more focusing on character defects and shortcomings. Circuit speakers who only desire to speak at conventions to be seen and heard, Literature based workshops and speakers tend to be poorly attended. These are concerns that are reaching across our fellowship and perhaps it is time to realize how important programming is to a successful convention.effective use of the schedule will help too. I.E not scheduling service workshops up against more attended workshops (mens/womens rap, relationship workshops etc) screening main speakers should also become a priority as well; let's not just bring a speaker in become we like their submission, let's find out a bit more how these speakers apply this program in their lives.

2. Terry (Tri-State) Presented us with a user friendly website update and a way to access information using twitter and RSS feeds
3. Kim B (Central Atlantic Region RD) Discussed using technology for larger regions/rural regions. Groups, GSR's and RCM's that are unable or unwilling to travel can use a number of methods to collaborate within their service levels and commitments

When this workgroup started i thought we would just be discussing the drawbacks and problems we are having with members posting/sharing info on their personal social media sites. This turned out to be an informative presentation that was easily explained and it showed me how we can use these new tools in order to gather our information and to work together if we are unable to meet face to face.
