WNYR continues to provide services effectively, meeting every other month, without issue. The region continues to be comprised of the following areas: Buffalo, CAMNA – Central Alleghany Mountain Region, Chautauqua, New New York, Niagara Falls, and Niagara Orleans. Our boundaries are spiritual not geographic. Since our last report, the number of meetings in our Region has remained steady at approximately 220. The online meeting continues to meet and can be accessed by logging onto nawny.org. The homegroups throughout the Region continue to participate actively in carrying NA's message of hope and promise of freedom.

Also the Buffalo Area is in the planning process of its annual Recovery in the Woods (RITW XXV) Weekend event. The spiritual retreat was held in May so as not to conflict with the World Convention. Finally, in the spirit of unity, cooperation, and collaboration the WNY Region looks forward to hearing about any plans or progress concerning the New York State Delegate service project. Once again, continued participation will be based upon recommendations of the RD and RDA; as well as, the availability of resources.
